Summary Notes:

- N=124 Released more youth than all Redirection evidence bases models in FL
- Offences During Supervision (ODS) is 7% which is 16% LOWER than the state average
- N=73 - Successfully graduated more youth than any other Redirections program in the State
- 71 Days is average length of stay = 31 fewer days or 29% less time on the program
- 18% lower recidivism rate than the state average
