Over the past 8 years, Dr. Sells has conducted seminars in over 80 cities and spoken to over 20,000 professional counselors and parents, based on his first book, Treating the Tough Adolescent: A Family-Based, Step-by-Step Guide (New York: Guilford Press, 1998) and his second book, Parenting Your Out-of-Control Teenager (St. Martin's Griffin Press, 2001). This work is detailed at the Savannah Family Institute website (www.difficult.net). Over the past fourteen years, Dr. Sells has personally treated over 800 difficult children. Using this experience and his research he has developed a 6-week parenting education program, Parenting With Love and Limits ® for parents and teenagers.
